

2017 Agganis Foundation Scholarship Guidelines



THE AGGANIS FOUNDATION HAS AWARDED \$1.75 MILLION IN SCHOLARSHIPS TO 927 STUDENT-ATHLETES SINCE IT WAS FOUNDED IN 1955 TO HONOR THE MEMORY OF LYNN CLASSICAL, BOSTON UNIVERSITY AND RED SOX STANDOUT HARRY AGGANIS. THIS YEAR, THE FOUNDATION WILL AGAIN AWARD SCHOLARSHIPS WORTH \$4,000 EACH (\$1,000 PER YEAR FOR FOUR YEARS) TO DESERVING STUDENT-ATHLETES. TO BE ELIGIBLE, AN APPLICANT MUST:

- * reside OR attend school in: Lynn, Lynnfield, Marblehead, Nahant, Peabody, Salem, Saugus, and/or Swampscott; OR reside AND attend school in Boston;*
- * have a grade-point-average of at least 3.0*
- * participate in a minimum of one varsity sport (not including cheerleading).*
- * attend an MIAA member school at the time of application;*
- * be accepted at a four-year accredited college.*

INTERESTED STUDENTS SHALL SUBMIT APPLICATIONS TO THE AGGANIS SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE BY **Apr. 27**.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE SCREENED BY A COMMITTEE THAT INCLUDES SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS, PRINCIPALS, ATHLETIC DIRECTORS, COACHES AND SPORTSWRITERS. FINAL SELECTIONS ARE MADE BY THE COMMITTEE AND AN AGGANIS FOUNDATION TRUSTEE. SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS WILL BE NOTIFIED BY **May 31**.
